Aldbrough St John Website Accessibility Statement

1. Introduction

The Parish Council is required to have a website accessible for all users and a Website Accessibility Statement, this is a requirement of the Public Sector Bodies (Website and Mobile Applications) (No 2) Accessibility Regulations 2018, which came into force in September 2018.

This statement has been compiled by reviewing the national guidelines and sample statements from similar bodies.

2. Website Accessibility Statement

The website is run by Aldbrough St John Parish Council, Accessibility is reviewed regularly to monitor ease of use. Website users should be able to:

- Change colours, contrast levels and fonts using built in browser settings.
- Zoom in up to 300% without text spilling off the screen
- Navigate most of the website using just the keyboard
- Listen to most of the website using a screen reader (including the most recent versions of JAWS, NVDA and voice over)
